

# Law no .18,552 dated 15/09/2015

State Standard - Paraná - Published in the Official Gazette (DOE) on September 16, 2015

Addresses the ban on the use of food residues containing animal protein of whatever origin for feeding Suidae

The Legislative Assembly of the State of Paraná decrees, and I ratify, the following Law:

Article 1. The utilization of food residues containing animal proteins of whichever origin for swine feeding is forbidden, except when heat treated to render the Classical Swine Fever (CSF) virus inactive.

Paragraph 1. The aforementioned heat treatment renders the CSF virus inactive at a temperature over 90°C (ninety degrees Celsius) for 60 minutes with continuous stirring.

Paragraph 2. The presence of swine on garbage dumps is forbidden, as well as collecting and using food waste from such places to feed the animals.

Article 2. The use of food or food remnants, that have come from airports, highway bus stations, train stations, sea and river ports, hospitals and the like, is banned for the feeding of any animal species.

Article 3. This Law shall come into force on its publication date.
