23/07/2020 Law no .18,669 dated

LAW no. 18,669 DATED 22/12/2015

Addresses the duties to be complied with, and guidelines to be met, by transporters of live animals with added commercial value that are of livestock health concern.

The Legislative Assembly of the State of Paraná decrees, and I ratify the following Law:

Article 1. Live animals of concern to animal health, with added commercial value, for breeding, growing, fattening, reproduction or slaughter shall be transported on roads and highways in the state of Paraná accompanied by an Animal Movement Permit (GTA - Guia de Trânsito Animal) and its respective invoice regarding the transported load.

Sole paragraph. The GTA will be issued by the state-level animal health agency with data that the Executive Branch defines as necessary, according to Law no. 11,504, dated August 6, 1996.

Article 2. Each and every vehicle transporting animals, hatching eggs, animal products, and by-products and residues must stop at the agricultural movement inspection posts and movable sanitary checkpoints.

Sole paragraph. Vehicles carrying live animals of concern to animal health, with added commercial value, for breeding, growing, fattening, reproduction or slaughter shall stop in the inspection posts of the State Highway Police in the entire State of Paraná.

Article 3. In the absence of animal health inspectors in the posts of the State Highway Police, the Executive Branch is authorized to appoint a deputy public agent in order to make sure that the Animal Movement Permit (GTA) and Invoice are correct, and notify the competent agency in charge.

Article 4. The Executive Branch shall regulate this Law and the administrative measures arising from failure to comply with it.

Article 5. This Law shall come into force on its publication date.
